Expenses During Spring Vacation

Spring Vacation: (Saturday, March 7, 2021 – Saturday, March 13, 2021):

During vacations, the regular university dormitories are closed. In the past, temporary university housing was available at the cost of \$28.00 per day (\$125/week) for a double room with a \$5.00 linen fee.

Students should also budget approximately \$20 a day for meals.
